For all salt usage, *Causeway Produce Agency* only use Cheetham Salt products. Cheetham Salt has developed a new product **RAM No 3 Dried Coarse Salt** for *Causeway Produce Agency* mixes. This product has reduced moisture level and special grain size to assist in developing a high quality *Causeway Produce Agency*.

Supplementing livestock rations with salt is an accepted and essential practice, to encourage optimum weight gain, yields and performance. Many commonly used feeds are deficient in one or both of the two minerals, which make up salt – sodium and chloride. Salt also improves the taste of the ration, encouraging the uptake of other nutrients.

The RAM range contains stock and feed grade salts suitable for most animal rations. Naturally crystallised for sea water and salt lakes by the action of sun and wind, they also contain amounts of other essential minerals, namely calcium, magnesium and potassium. Sulphate is also present; however, levels of this mineral, namely calcium, magnesium and potassium. Sulphate is also present; however, levels of this mineral are reduced by careful washing of the salt in brine prior to further refining.

The exact amount of salt required by an animal depends on a number of things, including:

- Type of animal
- Stage of growth (age)
- Health
- Type of feeds being consumed
- Level of work or production of the animal

### TIPS FOR SAFE FEEDING WHEN USING SALT

1. Consumption levels must be adjusted for salt starved animals as fatalities may occur. Start with a low level of the total daily ration and increase gradually over a period of a few weeks following specialist's nutritional advice.
2. Ensure there is always fresh water available to your animals, a safe distance from the mix. We only recommend a kiln dried product when mixing with urea as this has a reduced moisture level.
3. Wet salt can dissolve urea; a high concentration of urea can kill cattle. When urea is used in a mix there is always a potential danger.
4. We do not recommend the use of NON CRUSHED HARVEST SALT for stock mixes
5. RAM the right Animal Mix
